Gentlemen:

Under supervision of the Board of Park Commissioners, contracts will shortly be let for the construction of the "TORREY PINES LODGE" at Torrey Pines Park, at a cost of approximately \$20,000.00.

It is desired that gas and electric service be furnished, and it is requested that you advise this office as to your facilities for furnishing such service at this time, or what installation will be required before such service can be given.

The Lodge will be constructed on the east line of the right-of-way of Roosevelt Memorial Drive and a short distance south of the summit of the Torrey Pines grade.

The superintendent of parks, Mr. Morley, will go over the ground with you if a personal inspection is desired, or can give you the exact location on the city map.
