Dear Sir, At the time the City Council passed on the plans for the Lodge Building at Torrey Pines Park my system of sewage disposal was part of the plans and specifications submitted by the Architects Requa and Jackson. I am advised that Mr. Harper Miss Scripps representative contemplates abandoning that part of the plans and specifications relative to my system of sewage disposal as prepared for Messrs. Requa and Jackson Architects by me and accepted by them, whereupon I made no charge in view of the fact that I was told my report was accepted and my estimate of cost was satisfactory and the work was to be done by me. In view of these facts I am feeling that an injustice is about to be done me. And possibly it is intended to install through some one else a less efficient system that would be an infringement on my patent. Believing that the City Council do not wish to be a party to such unjust and illegal acts I am notifying you regarding this matter so that you may place this information before them with a view to prevent any unpleasant complications.
