Dear Sir:

This is to certify that the Board of Park Commissioners has formally approved the fulfillment of a contract for construction at Torrey Pines Lodge, by J. H. Nicholson, contractor, the total amount of said contract being \$11,000.

You are further advised that we have a formal acceptance of the completed work, signed by Messrs. Requa & Jackson, architects, by H. L. Jackson.

It is specified in the contract with Mr. Nicholson that Mr. Nicholson shall receive 85% of the contract price upon completion of the work and acceptance of same by the Board of Park Commissioners, and that the remaining 15% of the whole contract price shall remain unpaid until the expiration of thirty-five days from the completion of the contract and acceptance of the work and materials thereunder.
