I would state that a few days ago, Mr. Faulconer of the Park Board called on me and at that time we decided upon an arrangement satisfactory to the Telephone Company and one which Mr. Faulconer thought would be passed upon by the proper City authorities, to take care of the construction expense in connection with installing a telephone at the Torrey Pines Lodge, a portion of the expense to be paid by the City or Park Board and to be paid on monthly installments.
