Dear Sir:

The Park Commission directs me to advise you as follows:

(1). This office will endeavor to secure, through the mayor and chief of police, ample traffic supervision for Torrey Pines Park on Sundays and public holidays.

(2). That the superintendent of parks has been directed to take up the question of waterproofing refrigerating room, adobe walls and interior floors, using Barlith or other firstclass preparation for the work.

(3). That this department will defray the labor costs of changing toilet system at the Lodge, and will meet such other construction expenses as may arise.

(4). That the superintendent of parks has been directed to immediately take care of grading and surfacing of walks and drives adjacent to Lodge, the treatment of same to be such as he might deem most suitable.

(5). That every effort has been made to secure telephone service at the Lodge, and that this office will do its utmost to hasten the installation. Also that this office is endeavoring to secure more adequate water service and that it is hoped that a larger pipeline will be installed after the spring election.

The Park Commissioners greatly appreciate all that Miss Scripps has done and will do everything that is permitted them under the city charter for the improvement of this property.
