Dear Mr. Faulconer:

In reference to the program at the Torrey Pines Lodge for April 7th, Mr. Fleming, Mr. Burkholder and myself discussed the matter fully yesterday, and arrived at the following conclusions, all of which are subject to the approval of the board:

There will be no barbecue or any attempt to feed large crowds for lunch. The program will be in the afternoon at 2:30, and the publicity will simply state that lunch will be served to those who care to go out in the morning. Music will be rendered during the afternoon. The formal program will be as follows:

- (1) History of the Torrey Pines by John <sup>Mc</sup>Groarty if Mr. Forward can secure him. If not, we will secure some other local speaker.
- (2) Presentation of the lodge by Mr. Harper.
- (3) Acceptance <sup>of</sup> the Park Board by Judge Ryan.

Someone will have to act as chairman of the day, and this has not yet been decided on. It has been suggested that the Mayor make an address. The advice of the other members of the Park Board is requested.

Invitations will be issued to all prominent people, and a campaign of publicity will be started in plenty of time. I will be glad to have you take these matters up on Friday at the meeting.
