

I desire to call your attention to the urgent need of police supervision at the head of the Torrey Pines grade. The accident there last night, which is likely to cause two or three deaths, simply emphasizes a need that has been apparent to some of us for a long time. On account of the city's failure to meet this situation, Mr. Guy L. Fleming, who is employed as custodian and paid by Miss Ellen B. Scripps, has been compelled to neglect the work for which he is employed to act as policeman. I ask you to see that this situation is remedied.

I expressly ask you to make provision for this situation next Monday the 10th when it is certain that there will be a particularly large crowd at the Torrey Pines.
