Gentlemen:

Two weeks ago I called upon you with the proposal that a celebration be held at the Torrey Pines on Admission Day, September the ninth, commemorating the seventyfifth anniversary of the discovering of the Torrey Pines; dedicating these trees at that time to the State of California as her Birthday Trees. Since my appearing before you I have learned that, aside from the Grape Day event at Escondido, several programs have been arranged for the day, all of which might prevent our getting the affair over in a fitting manner.

On talking the matter over with Mr. Morley, Mr. Abbott, and with representatives of the local Parlor of Native Sons, it has been suggested that September 12th, the Saturday after Admission Day, be announced as the date for celebrating the Diamond Jubilee of the discovery of the Torrey Pines.
