


To The Honorable Mayor and City Council,

The following resolution was duly passed at our regular meeting
held May 5th, 1930:

Resolved:

"That we deplore the unfortunate condition of the City relative to the coast highway north, and that we praise and are in hearty accord with the City Council in its efforts to put such a road through the so-called Torey Pines Park as in the present financial condition of the City that seems the only way to get the needed highway to the north. We commend and urge the council not only to appeal from the decision of the Superior Court restraining the building of such a road, but also to take any other procedure which may accomplish the same results in the shortest time possible.
