- As I announced at last month's meeting, historical resources staff members who are now part of
  the Development Services Department will be physically relocating to that department. The date
  has been set, and the move will occur next Tuesday, August 30<sup>th</sup>. Jodie, Camille, Suzanne and
  Shannon will be physically relocating to the Development Services Department building at 1222
  First Avenue. Beginning August 31<sup>st</sup>, all historic resource nomination submittals, Mills Act
  applications, initial consultation and project review meetings with staff, and stamp transfers will
  occur at the Development Services building.
