





811 S. 28th Street, San Diego, CA 92113

- The 3,000 square-feet building was constructed in 1927
- The shell of the building consists of:
 - Clay tile roof over heavy timber wood framing
 - Wood framed walls with stucco finish on the exterior and plaster finish on the interior
 - Concrete slab-on-grade











State grant will fund the rehabilitation of the building shell for future use, including but not limited:

- 1. Roof repair
- Mechanical and plumbing fixtures repair
- 3. Window repairs
- Electrical system repairs



Building Rehabilitation Milestones (estimates):

- CIP project establishment (3 months)
- Consultant procurement and design (12 months)
- Permitting (3 months)
- Bid & Award (6 months)
- Construction (12 months)

Survey Outcome and Future Use Implementation

Outcome:

- A. City will collect and organize data.
- B. City will present data to show community preference.
- C. Follow-up meetings will be schedule begin next steps

Next Steps:

- Additional funding to be identified to implement the future use and programing
