WHEREAS, the Great White Fleet was composed of 16 battleships and 14,000 officers and men; and

WHEREAS, the Great White Fleet Veteran's Association was established in 1945 by the surviving members of that cruise; and

WHEREAS, the Great White Fleet Veteran's Association is one of the oldest veteran organizations today; and

WHEREAS, the Great White Fleet Veteran's Association will be celebrating its 29th annual reunion on Monday, December 16, at the U.S. Grant Hotel in San Diego;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PETE WILSON, the Twenty-ninth Mayor of the City of San Diego, do hereby proclaim Monday, December 16, 1974, to be "GREAT WHITE FLEET DAY" in San Diego, and further commend the Great White Fleet Veteran's Association for its efforts in establishing recognition for America at home and abroad.
