

RESOLUTION NO. 12752

WHEREAS, Section 43, Chapter 2, Article II, of the City Charter gives to the Common Council the power to provide a common seal for the city of San Diego, and from time to time to alter and change the same, and

WHEREAS, In the opinion of this Common Council, the present seal of the city of San Diego is not in any way symbolic or representative of the municipality as it exists to-day, and

WHEREAS, It is the desire of said Common Council to have a more appropriate seal designed for use as the official seal of said city, now be it

RESOLVED, That the City Clerk be and he is hereby authorized and directed to invite the submission of competitive designs for such an official seal, said designs to be submitted without compensation, further than the formal acceptance and thanks of the Council for the design which may be finally approved by this body; said designs to be submitted to the Clerk on or before the fifteenth day of February, 1913.

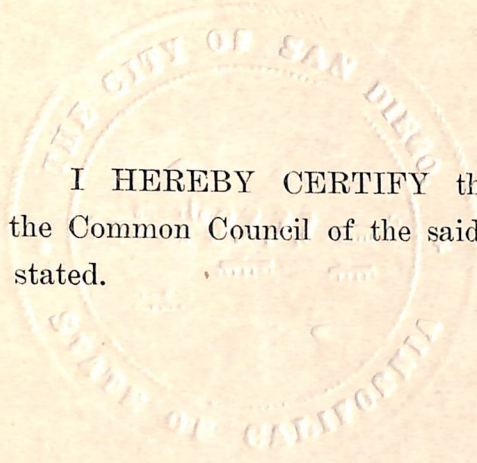
