

Resolution No. 17024

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Common Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

WHEREAS, Under the provisions of Ordinance No.174 of the Ordinances of the City of San Diego, approved January 5th, 1888, the seal of the said City shall be circular, two and one-fourth inches in diameter, and having in the center any design adopted by the said Common Council, and the following inscription surrounding the same: "The City of San Diego, State of California," and

WHEREAS, The City Clerk was, by Resolution No. 12752, adopted January 27th, 1913, authorized to call for competitive designs for a new official seal for the City, and

WHEREAS, Certain designs were submitted in response to said call, including one prepared by Carleton Monroe Winslow of the City of San Diego, a full description of which is set out in Document No.74869 on file in the City Clerk's office, the said design also being on file in said office, and

WHEREAS, Said design is deemed to be the most appropriate one submitted, now be it

RESOLVED, That the said design, submitted by the said Carleton Monroe Winslow, and as described in said Document No.74869, be and it is hereby accepted and adopted for the official seal of the said City of San Diego, California.
