February 2024 Rain Event Staffing for February 1st & 2nd, 2024

## 1<sup>st</sup> Watch (**Deleted – records of security**)

- NPD, Traffic, Traffic Motors, Traffic RSVPs, Police Code Compliance Officers, TSF,
  PEOs and SETCs will be assigned to the Incident Management Team (IMT) for storm related issues.
- All Patrol will respond as normal for City wide radio calls. As needed, under the direction of the Field Lieutenant &/or Department Operations Center (DOC), patrol may be pulled to handle flood specific emergencies.
- o Schedules will be submitted to the Watch Commander at the beginning of the shift.

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Watch (**Deleted – records of security**)

- o Patrol Divisions will designate one squad at each command to answer radio calls and will designate one squad on the patrol schedule for storm relief.
- Squads designated for storm relief will be divided between the IMT and DOC operations as needed.
- o Schedules will be submitted to the Watch Commander at the beginning of the shift.

## 3<sup>rd</sup> Watch (**Deleted – records of security**)

- o TSF and Special Events will be assigned to the IMT for storm related issues.
- All Patrol will respond as normal for City wide radio calls. As needed, under the direction of the Field Lieutenant &/or the Department Operations Center, patrol could be pulled to handle flood specific emergencies.
- o Schedules will be submitted to the Watch Commander at the beginning of the shift.

Area Station investigations personnel should be in uniform and prepared to respond to storm relief operations as assigned. Centralized investigations personnel shall have a uniform

ready and shall be prepared to respond to storm relief operations as needed. All investigative units will submit schedules to the Watch Commander's office at the beginning of shift.
