NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

SPECIAL EVENTS DEPARTMENT

PROJECT NAME: Special Event Permit - San Diego Greek Festival

COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: North Park

COUNCIL DISTRICT: 3

LOCATION: St Spyridon Church, 3655 Park Boulevard, 3680 Indiana St, San Diego CA 92103

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Special Event Permit for a 2-day Greek festival that would include vendors, food, alcohol, fenced in beer garden, a stage, entertainment, and the temporary use of food preparation, canopies, generator, fencing and/or barriers, trash/recycling containers, tables and chairs that would occur at St Spyridon Church and parking lot, and the adjacent portion of the alley between Cypress Avenue and Park Boulevard on June 8-9, 2024. Alcohol would be served from 11 AM until 9:30 PM on June 8, 2024, and from 11 AM until 8:30 PM on June 9, 2024. Noise associated with the event activities and set-up/dismantling would occur from 9 AM on June 6, 2024, until 8 PM on June 10, 2024. Set-up would occur on June 6, 2024, from 9 AM until 8 PM, on June 7, 2024, from 9 AM until 8 PM, and on June 8, 2024, from 8 AM until 11 AM. The two-day event would occur on June 8, 2024, from 11 AM until 10 PM, and on June 9, 2024, from 11 AM until 9 PM. Dismantling would occur on June 10, 2024, from 9 AM until 8 PM. There would be a stage with entertainment and sound amplifications would occur from 10 AM until 10 PM. Approximately 3,300 attendees are anticipated throughout the course of the event.

Parking closures would be associated with the event and would occur from 9 AM on June 7, 2024, until 5 PM on June 10, 2024, and would include both sides of Cypress Street between Park Boulevard and E. Alley of Park Boulevard, and both side of Indiana Street between Cypress Street and Park Boulevard.

Street closures would be associated with the event and would occur include the alley between Park Boulevard and Cypress Street from 9 AM on June 5, 2024, until 5 PM on June 10, 2024, Cypress Street between Park Boulevard and Alley from 9 AM until 11 PM on June 8, 2024, and from 9 AM until 10 PM on June 9, 2024, and west side of Indiana Street along church property from 9 AM on June 7, 2024, until 5 PM on June 10, 2024.

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities); Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land); Section 15311 (Accessory Structures).

ENTITY MAKING ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: City of San Diego Mayor-Appointed Designee

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section(s): Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) which allows for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing or minor alterations of existing public or private structures or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use; Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land) which allows for minor, temporary use of land that has negligible or no permanent effects on the environment; Section 15311 (Accessory Structures) which allows for construction, or placement of minor structures accessory to existing commercial, industrial, or institutional facilities, including, but not limited to, temporary use items in publicly owned facilities or other facilities designated for public use; and where the exceptions listed in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action; and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.
