

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

North City Pure Water Pipeline Construction on Businesspark Avenue

May 9, 2024

Pipeline construction is underway on the City of San Diego's North City Pure Water Pipeline project on Businesspark Avenue between Carroll Canyon Road and Willow Creek Road. Crews have already installed the pipeline on Businesspark Avenue between Willow Creek Road and the Scripps Ranch horse ranch property (private property) to Interstate 15.

What To Expect: Construction activities include trenching and pipe installation, backfilling and trench restoration, as well as hauling of various materials.

Two-way traffic will continue to be maintained, and access will be maintained for businesses and emergency responders. As soon as it is feasible and safe, the intersection of Businesspark Avenue and Willow Creek Road will be re-opened to through traffic. Please follow all posted signage and crew member directions.

When: Construction is scheduled from Monday to Thursday nights, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. on Businesspark Avenue through July 2024. There is no daytime work associated with this project. However, there is daytime work scheduled as part of two other projects in the area: the City of San Diego's AC Water Group Job 1038 project and the Scripps Ranch Improvements Project, which both include the replacement of water mains on Carroll Canyon Road, Businesspark Avenue and Willow Creek Road. Road restoration will be completed after construction of all three projects, currently anticipated in late 2024.

The North City Pure Water Pipeline project is one of several major infrastructure projects that are part of Phase 1 of Pure Water San Diego. The pipeline will start on Eastgate Mall and follow Miramar Road to Kearny Villa Road and continue along Candida Street to Via Pasar and Via Excelencia. From there, the pipeline will tunnel under Interstate 15. On the east side of Interstate 15, it will continue along Businesspark Avenue to Carroll Canyon Road and follow Hoyt Park Drive to Meanley Drive before crossing Scripps Lake Drive to the Miramar Reservoir.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities. Properties along the project alignment will receive printed notices before work begins near their address, and construction notices will be regularly posted on scrippsranh.purewatersd.org.
