

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: Work Scheduled on Kika Court Associated with Penasquitos Pump Station Oxygenation System

May 23, 2024

On June 3, 2024, work is scheduled to take place on the City of San Diego property on Kika Court associated with the Penasquitos Pump Station Oxygenation System Project.

What To Expect: Construction on Kika Court will include on-site trenching and pipe

installation, and system sensor installation. Neighbors may see increased vehicle traffic and construction equipment on Kika Court, and during the day, neighbors may hear construction noise. The City's contractor will

minimize construction impacts as much as possible.

When: Construction is scheduled from Monday to Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30

p.m. beginning in June 2024 for approximately one month. This duration is

subject to change pending material and equipment availability.

Why: This project is associated with Pure Water San Diego, the City of San

Diego's phased, multi-year program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035. The Pure Water Program will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The Program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water needs and will provide a reliable,

sustainable water supply.

The Penasquitos Pump Station pumps wastewater to the North City Water Reclamation Plant (NCWRP) on Eastgate Mall. To improve the quality of the water and maintain treatment conditions at the NCWRP, the City will add

high purity oxygen at the Penasquitos Pump Station.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities. Construction notices will be regularly posted on purewatersd.org.
