Police Investigate Suspicious Death of Male in Serra Mesa

San Diego – On June 22, 2024, at approximately 2:42 p.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received a call from a concerned citizen regarding a deceased male in the west alley of 2800 Greyling Drive in the Serra Mesa Neighborhood of San Diego. Officers from Eastern Division and personnel from the San Diego Fire-Rescue Department were immediately dispatched and arrived within minutes. Upon arriving they located an obviously deceased male in the alley. Due to the unusual circumstances surrounding the death of the male and in an abundance of caution, San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene to investigate.

It is still early in the investigation, and little is known about the circumstances leading up to the male's death. However, it does appear the male died at a different location and his body was left in the alley by an unknown person(s). It is unclear at this time what the exact events were that led up to the male's death or why his body was left at the location where he was found. At this time, Detectives are still in the process of examining physical evidence from the scene, attempting to locate and interview witnesses and canvassing the area for surveillance footage that might provide more insight into the events leading up to the male's death or his body being left in the alley.

At this time, the male has not been identified but he is believed to be a Hispanic male in his 30's or 40's. The exact cause of death and confirmation of the male's injuries are pending further examination by the San Diego County Medical Examiner's Office.
