Police Investigate Suspicious Death of Female in Clairemont

San Diego – On June 25, 2024, at approximately 4:54 a.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received a report of a deceased female in a residence in the 4000 block of Mount Albertine Avenue in the Clairemont neighborhood of San Diego. Officers from Northern Division were dispatched immediately and arrived within minutes. Upon arriving, they located an obviously deceased female inside the residence. The female's injuries were undetermined due to the level of decomposition and the positioning of the female's body. However, due to unusual circumstances surrounding the death of the female and in an abundance of caution, San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene to investigate.

It is still early in the investigation, and little is known about the circumstances leading up to the female's death. It is undetermined at this time if the female was a visitor or resided at the home on Mount Albertine Avenue. Two adult males who were present at the residence were detained and Detectives are currently evaluating their roles in this incident. At this time, Detectives are still in the process of examining physical evidence from the scene, attempting to locate and interview witnesses and canvassing the area for surveillance footage that might provide more insight into the events leading up to the female's death.

The female has not been identified. She is described as Chinese or Asian in her 20's or early 30's. The two detained males are described as Chinese or Asian and are in their early 30's.
