A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO COUNCIL POLICY 600-24 "STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES AND RESPONSIBILITIES FOR RECOGNIZED COMMUNITY PLANNING GROUPS."

WHEREAS, in September of 2022, the City Council approved amendments to Council Policy 600-24 "Standard Operating Procedures and Responsibilities for Recognized Community Planning Groups" along with amendments to the City's Municipal Code to better reflect the independent legal status of Community Planning Groups (CPGs); and

WHEREAS, this resolution proposes amendments to Council Policy 600-24 in four main areas in addition to some minor editorial edits; and

WHEREAS, in the first area City Planning Department staff is proposing an amendment to Council Policy 600-24 to address the potential recognition process of new unelected CPGs by allowing City Council to recognize a new CPG contingent upon their creation of an independent election committee and the completion of elections for new voting members within 90 days after City Council action; and

WHEREAS, in the second area, City Planning Department staff proposes amendments to allow CPG members to attend virtual CPG meetings without providing their teleconference location and posting agendas at all teleconference locations. However, CPG annual elections must provide an in-person voting option; and

WHEREAS, in the third area, City Planning Department staff proposes amendments to include a requirement that annual reports shall be submitted to the City within 14 days of the approval of the March minutes and include a summary list of accomplishments, and major

actions on large projects and policy matters covering a calendar year from April through the following month of March; and

WHEREAS, in the fourth area, City Planning Department staff proposes amendments to include a procedure for CPGs to amend their operating procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that Council Policy 600-24 is amended as set forth in the Council Policy on file with the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 315560

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council directs the City Clerk to update the Council Policy Manual to reflect the amended Council Policy.
