**Police Investigate Stabbing Death in Mira Mesa**

On July 12, 2024, at approximately 3:25 a.m., Officers from Northern Division responded to a local hospital to investigate a report of a male who had been stabbed. The male had been brought to the hospital by a female. The male was rushed into treatment but, despite the best efforts of medical personnel, the male was pronounced deceased.

During their preliminary investigation, Officers learned that the possible location of the stabbing was a residence in the 11000 block of Mont Blanc Drive in Mira Mesa. Officers from Northeastern Division responded and discovered the likely stabbing scene inside the residence.

The preliminary information gathered shows that the male and female are believed to be in a dating relationship. There was some type of argument at the residence. During that argument, a knife was present, and the male suffered a fatal stab wound. It is not clear yet what the exact events were that led up to the male being stabbed.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene to investigate. At this time, detectives are in the process of examining physical evidence from the scene, attempting to locate and interview witnesses, canvassing the area for surveillance footage, and taking all investigative steps to determine the events that occurred surrounding the stabbing.

The male has been identified. However, his name is not being released pending family notifications. He is described as a 40-year-old Black male.

The female that was involved in the argument has been identified and detained but her identity is not being released at this time.
