Homicide Investigation in Palm City

On Tuesday, July 23, 2024, at approximately 7:50 PM, the San Diego Police Communications Center received a report of a stabbing at 600 Hollister Street. Officers from Southern Division responded and located a male at the Palm Avenue Trolley Station suffering from at least one stab wound. Transit Security and the responding officers began lifesaving measures. Paramedics arrived and transported the male to a local hospital where, unfortunately, he was pronounced deceased.

The male has not yet been identified. Detectives will work with the San Diego County Medical Examiner's Office to determine his identity. He appears to be a Hispanic male, possibly a teenager or young adult.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene to investigate. The preliminary information gathered at this time is there was a physical fight on the west sidewalk of 600 Hollister Street. The fight moved into a nearby parking lot. The participants were a small group of Hispanic males. During the fight, the victim was stabbed. He ran across the street to the trolley station where he was ultimately located. The suspect ran to a small dark colored vehicle which fled southbound on Hollister Street. The suspect is described as a Hispanic male, youthful in appearance, possibly a teenager or young adult. There is no further information to release on the suspect at this time.

Detectives are continuing to investigate this incident, including attempting to locate and interview witnesses, and canvassing the area for surveillance footage. Detectives would like to speak to anyone that may have witnessed the event but left before officers arrived at the scene.
