

**CONSTRUCTION NOTICE:
Pipeline Work Continues West on Nobel Drive
for the Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels Project**

In **early July**, construction crews will start a new phase of construction in the westbound lanes of Nobel Drive between Via Las Rambles and Lombard Place as part of the City of San Diego Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels project in University City.

After setting up new traffic control, crews will continue installing one 48-inch wastewater pipeline and one 30-inch brine pipeline.

Two-way traffic will be maintained at all times. The traffic signal for the intersection of Nobel Dr. and Lombard Pl. will be switched to "flashing," and flaggers will be onsite as needed to help direct traffic. Parking restrictions will be in place around the construction area. Please see the map on Page 2 for details on the affected areas.

Working hours for this segment will be from Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. and occasionally on Saturday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. This work will continue through Summer 2024.

What to Expect:

- A single lane in each direction in the Nobel Drive eastbound lanes. The westbound lanes will continue to be closed for pipeline construction.
- "No parking" signs will be placed on Nobel Drive and Lombard Place as needed. Parking restrictions will be enforced; please avoid parking in areas with "no parking" signs. Vehicles in violation of these signs will be towed.
- 24/7 access for emergency vehicles, residences and businesses will be maintained.
- For safety reasons, please follow all posted signage. Please anticipate traffic delays, construction noise and overnight construction lights.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities. Properties along the construction area will receive printed notices before work begins near their address, and construction notices will be posted on utc.purewatersd.org.
