

Aquatic Activities Resume at Miramar Reservoir This Weekend

On Saturday, July 6, Miramar Reservoir will reopen for on-water recreation activities following the successful installation of the subaqueous pipeline, as part of the Pure Water Program.

Miramar Reservoir - the “future home of Pure Water” - will welcome boats, canoes, kayaks and float tubes beginning this Saturday. Shore areas, including picnic and BBQ areas, paths and shore fishing, are still accessible.

When the reservoir closed to on-water recreation in September 2023, construction plans estimated the reservoir would reopen by September 2024. We’re proud to be able to reopen ahead of schedule and allow the community two summer months of on-water access. While on-water recreation resumes this weekend, the parking lot repaving is scheduled to occur in August, which will mark the conclusion of the Subaqueous Pipeline Project.
