Share with the group about the department in charge of the “get it done APP and how it works. Panda is a new part of the “get it Done App” department. It's been around since 2016, but now pandas are more uptake because of data collecting, which provides the department with information on other areas which the "get it done APP" is working and the areas that are not using the “Get it Done APP" but should” and then the department would do a lot more marketing in those areas they are not using the “get it done app.”

The average time it takes to get it done is three to four days. However, different departments within the city for different categories can take much longer to get the job done.
