










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#### **2023 ADU Home Building Permits Issued**



*New ADU homes permitted for construction in 2023* 










#### **2023 Family Homes Issued Building Permits**


















#### 2014 – 2023 Trend Analysis of Homes Issued Building Permits

#### Homes Permitted Since 2014






#### Issued Home Permits in Mobility Zones Since 2021




New homes permitted since 2021 are in Mobility Zones 1 and 2




