

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE:

Pure Water Tunnel Construction on Genesee Avenue between Centurion Square and Decoro Street for the City of San Diego Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels Project

On **Sunday, September 15**, the northbound lanes on Genesee Avenue will be closed between Centurion Square and Decoro Street. All traffic will be switched to the southbound lanes of Genesee Avenue, with single-lane traffic in each direction.

Crews will begin construction work on the third tunneling shaft south of Decoro Street on Genesee Avenue to connect with the recently completed shaft at Rose Canyon. Please see the map on Page 2 for details on the traffic control and tunnel sites.

Working hours for this next segment of tunnel work will be Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Construction will continue through Fall 2024. Access to the trails will be maintained.

The City and project team are committed to completing construction as efficiently as possible with safety as our highest priority, and the community's patience and coordination are appreciated.

What to Expect:

- Traffic will be maintained in both directions.
- Single-lane traffic north and south of Centurion Square.
- Two-lane northbound traffic restored prior to Decoro Street.
- 24/7 access for emergency vehicles, residences and businesses will be maintained.
- For safety reasons, please follow all posted signage. Please anticipate traffic delays, construction noise and overnight construction lights.

Why: Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's phased, multi-year program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035. The Pure Water San Diego Program will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The Program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water needs and will provide a reliable, sustainable water supply. The Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels project is one of several major water infrastructure projects in Phase 1 of Pure Water San Diego.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities. Properties along the construction area will receive printed notices before work begins near their address, and construction notices will be regularly posted on utc.purewatersd.org.
