






New Gymnasium



Activity Pool


- 30' x 50' = 1,500 SF
- Depths from 2'-6" to 4'-0"
- Walk-in Stairs along one side
- Supports learn-to-swim, therapy classes, fitness programs, open swimming, etc.





Splash Pad

- 2,300 SF
- Zero standing water
- Interactive features
- Can be themed
- Could include climb-on structure
- Potential for shaded area







Lap Pool

- 33-METERS x 25-YARD (108'X75')
- Depths from 3'-6" to 7'-0"
- Can support 25-yard floating cage and fixed cage water polo
- Provides 13 25-yard lap lanes



NEXT STEPS

- DESIGN TEAM GOES TO WORK DEVELOPING PROJECT AS SHOWN
