Perception of Safety - **67%** of respondents overall felt mostly or completely safe in their neighborhood. **46%** of respondents stated there was a place in their local area they did consider unsafe. The most frequent reason given for this perception (**48%**) was because they "Personally witnessed or been a victim of crime". **79%** of respondents reported not being victims of crime in the past 6 months, indicating expanded community perspective access via the Zencity survey.

The feed provides open text comments identifying general themes and specific issues and locations. Homelessness was identified as the primary concern citywide (**388 Respondents**) and was the main concern in 8/9 areas. Theft, Burglary and Break Ins (**173**) was the next highest concern followed by Streets and Traffic (**135**). **Click <u>here</u> to visit your site and explore your data.**







Number of responses by leading subtopic









