NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

SPECIAL EVENTS DEPARTMENT

PROJECT NAME: Special Event Permit - Susan G. Komen More than Pink Walk

COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: Balboa Park

COUNCIL DISTRICT: 3

LOCATION: Balboa Park and Balboa Park's 6th and Laurel Lawn (see attached maps)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Special Event Permit for a Susan G. Komen More than Pink Walk on November 3, 2024, within Balboa Park and on the Balboa Park's 6th and Laurel Lawn (see attached maps). The event would include a stage, sound amplification, music, generators, tents, tables, chairs, fencing and/or barriers, portable restrooms, and recycling/trash containers. Noise associated with the event activities and set-up/dismantling would occur from November 2, 2024, at 7 AM to November 4, 2024, at 8 AM. Set up would occur on November 2, 2024, from 7 AM to 4 PM, and from 5 AM to 6:30 AM. On November 3, 2024, the event would occur from 6:30 AM to 11 AM, and dismantling would occur from 11 AM to 5 PM, and from 6 AM until 8 AM on November 4, 2024.

Road closures would be associated with this event, and would occur on November 3, 2024, from 6 AM until 9:30 AM and would include the following:

- -6th Ave (northbound) between Upas St and Robinson
- -El Prado between 6th Ave and Pan American Rd
- Pan American Rd (eastbound) between El Prado and Presidents Way
- Presidents Way between Pan American E Dr. and parking lot
- Southbound Park Blvd. between Zoo Pl. and 163 on-ramp
- Robinson from 10th to 6th
- Balboa Dr. from 6th between Upas to Juniper
- -163 from A St. to Robinson

Parking closures would occur from 4 AM until 11 AM on November 3, 2024, and would include - Both sides of El Prado from Sixth to Pan American E.

- Both sides of Pan American E. from El Prado to Presidents Way.
- Both sides of Presidents Way from Pan American E. to Park Blvd.
- West curb of southbound Park Blvd from Presidents to 163 on-ramp.
- Both sides of Robinson from 10th to Sixth
- East curb of northbound 6th Ave from Upas to Robinson.
- Both sides of Balboa Dr. from Sixth/Upas to Juniper
- Sixth Ave from Juniper to Laurel (for Shuttle Drop Off)
- Balboa Dr. N. Lot2, and Inspiration Point parking lot.

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities); Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land); Section 15311 (Accessory Structures).

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section(s): Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) which allows for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing or minor alterations of existing public or private structures or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use; Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land) which allows for minor, temporary use of land that has negligible or no permanent effects on the environment; Section 15311 (Accessory Structures) which allows for construction, or placement of minor structures accessory to existing commercial, industrial, or institutional facilities, including, but not limited to, temporary use items in publicly owned facilities or other facilities designated for public use; and where the exceptions listed in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action; and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.
