PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Coastal Development Permit for the unpermitted interior and exterior demolition and reconstruction of an existing single residential dwelling totaling 1,542 square-foot which includes a 400 square-foot Junior Accessory Dwelling Unit on a 4,314 square-foot lot located at 5460 Linda Rosa Avenue. The 0.09-acre site is in the RS-1-7 Base Zone, Coastal (Non-appealable-2) Overlay Zone, Coastal Height Limit Overlay Zone, and Parking Impact Overlay Zone (PIOZ-Coastal - Impact) within the La Jolla Community Plan Area. LEGAL DESCRIPTION: LOT 28 IN BLOCK 27 OF BIRD ROCK ADDITION, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, COUNTY OF SAN DEIGO, ACCORDING TO MAP 1083 THEREOF, FIELD IN HTE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY RECORDER OF SAN DIEGO COUNTY JANUARY 27, 1908.

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego Development Services Department

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA State Guidelines, Section 15301, Existing Facilities.

ENTITY MAKING ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: City of San Diego

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The project meets the criteria outlined in CEQA Section 15301, which allows for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use. The project is proposing to permit unpermitted work on an existing dwelling unit. There would be no expansion of the existing use. The exceptions listed in CEQA Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified, no significant effect on the environment was

identified, and the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway. The site is not included on any list compiled pursuant to Government Code Section 65962.5 for hazardous waste sites.
