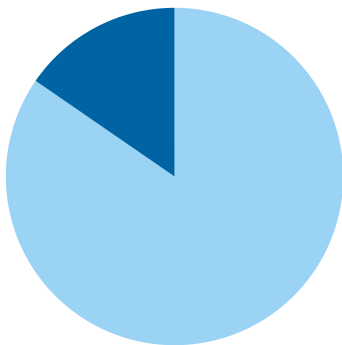

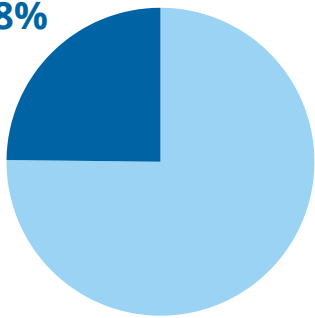
About the project: The Behavioral Health Services project focus on providing center-based, tele-health, and in home therapeutic mental services specialized for low-income children in San Diego.

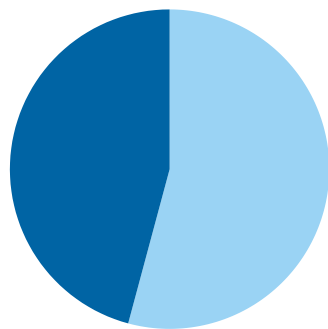

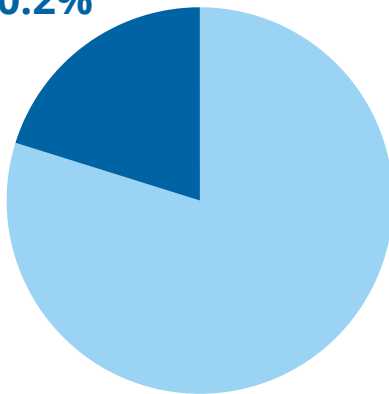
