## Priorities and Strategies

### **Goal: Create jobs and improve educational opportunities**

- **Objective I:** Support career exploration, education, and employment opportunities in the Promise Zone
  - **Priority:** Cultivate opportunities for career exploration, applied education, and youth leadership through digital inclusion
- **Objective II:** Create tangible employment opportunities with youth
  - **Priority:** Utilize partner networks to create employment opportunities and ensure youth are aware of all available avenues they can pursue

- **Objective III:** Provide emotional and educational support to address any achievement gaps exacerbated by remote learning and the pandemic

    - C. Engage with schools in the Promise Zone to learn how we can support their programs to support to students negatively affected by remote learning and the pandemic
