- 1. Call to Order:** The Meeting was brought to order at 11:35 AM by Jeff Sallen, Chair of the Kearny Mesa Planning Group.
- 2. Meeting Minutes:** The Meeting Minutes from July 2024 were shared with all participants. The minutes were approved 6-0-2.
- 3. Non-Agenda Public Comments:** Jeff Sallen asked if there were any public comments from the audience participants. Mr. Furbert introduced himself and campaigned on behalf of his wife heather Furbert who is running for City Attorney.

Following Mr. Furbert's announcement, City of San Diego Senior Planner, Corey Funk, introduced himself and informed the Planning Group to the upcoming land development code update.

4. Informational Items:

Michael Wilborn, Managing Partner, with the Alliance Residential Company presented a new residential development and the need for a partial easement vacation and sewer easement dedication. The new sewer line would replace the existing 8" pipe with a new 10" sanitary sewer line. The new line would also follow the existing easement placement which the current 8" pipe strays from.
