ITEM-1: ANNOUNCEMENTS/PUBLIC COMMENT - ISSUES WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE COMMISSION NOT PREVIOUSLY HEARD.

Dave Potter, Chairperson of CPC. Spoke to the transportation area overlay zone and the residential tandem parking overlay zone. Mr. Potter feels that a number of procedures were not properly followed in the noticing of these rezoning actions; plus CDC and the Community Planning Groups were never notified of these rezoning actions. The Commission was requested that they help to make sure these items are brought before the various community planning groups, as well as CPC when they are of a citywide issue.

Gary Halbert, Planning Department spoke to the status of the Street Design Manual and the meetings that have been conducted to date, and by whom to come up with a draft manual which should be available in February. Staff was requested to schedule a workshop to discuss this before it comes back for action.

A Steering Committee meeting has been scheduled for February 7; the Mayor's Smart Growth Implementation Committee will meet on February 15; Chairperson Anderson and Ms. Clementson will be on a breakfast panel for the Urban Land Institute to discussing Smart growth, City of Villages Concept.

Stephen Haase advised the Commission of City Council's action taken last week on several Development Services projects.

Chairperson Anderson extended congratulations and advised that Vice-Chairperson Lettieri has received a fellow with the American Institute of Planners, and he will receive his fellowship at the national conference in Chicago in April.
