On motion of CHRIS CALKINS, seconded by SCOTT BERNET, the Commission voted 6-0 to adopt paragraph 3, page 2 of CCDC staff report.

On motion of LYNN BENN, seconded by SCOTT BERNET, the Commission voted 6-0 to approve and recommend to City Council, the adoption of the ordinance and recommend the environmental document be certified with the following changes; technical changes pages 4 and 5, page 2 of the staff report, and the modification to respect to Area G.
