- 16 Classes scheduled at 2 Different Rec Centers -Bay Terraces Community and Senior Center, and Kearny Mesa
- Anticipated class size is 15 students









LION GOLF ACADEMY

- 325 New students since October 1, 2023.
- 157 Summer Camps
- 65% Junior golfers, 35% adult golfers
- Average ratio is 4:1
- Women's Beginner League up to 16 players weekly
- Program for people with Autism Spectrum Disorder



GOLF ENTERPRISE FUND

- The net income for Fiscal Year 2024 exceeded \$14 million.
- Expenses increased approximately \$2.4 million and are expected to increase as prices for goods and services remain high.
- Fee increases will be implemented on January 1, 2025, and will be capped at 3% for residents and 5% for non-residents.



GOLF ROUNDS

 In total the Golf Division hosted 419,843 rounds of golf between all five golf courses. This is the highest total in the past 20 years.


