Shiley Special Events Suite

The Shiley Special Events Suite on the 9th floor of the downtown San Diego Central Library is a 3,500 square foot versatile space with two adjoining terraces.

It comes with a projector, screen, DVD/BluRay player, two wireless microphone channels, and a podium with a wired microphone. We have 23 5' round tables, 14 rectangular 5' x 2' tables, and approximately 300 chairs. The suite also has its own private restrooms.

Neil Morgan Auditorium

The Neil Morgan Auditorium on the 1st floor is a 5,000 square foot space with 281 fixed seats and a small stage.

The auditorium comes with a brand new 16' x 9' LED screen, DVD/BluRay player, two wireless microphone channels, a podium with a wired microphone, and a baby grand piano. The back wall of the auditorium can also be opened to the large library courtyard and additional chairs may be added to the space. The auditorium also has its own private restrooms.

Mary Hollis Clark Conference Center

The Mary Hollis Clark Conference Center on the 1st floor is a 688 square foot meeting space with a capacity of 40 people.

The space comes with two large TVs, a podium with a wired microphone, 7 rolling tables and 40 chairs.

Performance Annex

The Performance Annex is a 2,500 square foot detached black-box theater space next to the City Heights Library. It has a capacity of 120 and has 4 rows of risers with chairs.

The space comes with 4 wireless microphone channels, bluetooth connectivity to play music, monitors by request and theatrical lighting presets. The space also has a roll-up door that opens to the park outside and can be used as a stage for outdoor programming as well.
