WATCH COMMANDER LINE-UP BRIEFING

I. <u>PURPOSE</u>

This Training Bulletin introduces the new practice where the Watch Commander's Office will hold a virtual Zoom meeting at the beginning of all Patrol Division shifts (0600 hours, 1400 hours, and 2100 hours).

II. SCOPE

This Training Bulletin applies to all Patrol Divisions.

III. <u>BACKGROUND</u>

In an effort to improve coordination in Patrol Operations, the Watch Commander's Office will administer a Zoom meeting before each Patrol Division conducts its individual line-up briefings.

The overall intent is for this to be a short and concise Zoom meeting for the benefit of all Patrol Divisions. The management of major crimes and incidents will take precedence over holding this meeting.

The Watch Commander Line-Up Briefing will cover the following elements:

Identification of patrol positions (Field Lieutenants, PRT Leader, MFF Sergeants), major active critical incidents, identification of special events, BOLO's, training bulletins, policy and procedure reminders or updates, and an opportunity to answer questions.

V. <u>GUIDELINES FOR MEETING</u>

- A. Patrol Division Sergeants will administer the Zoom meetings at their respective line-ups.
- B. Department line-up computers will be utilized to log into Zoom meetings.
- C. Any unidentified users will be removed from the meeting.
- D. The meetings will be broadcast on large screens in line-up rooms so all officers can access the information.

V. HOW TO ACCESS ZOOM MEETING

- A. Open Zoom meeting via Web Application.
- B. Enter the Zoom meeting ID number.
- C. Enter the Zoom meeting password.
- D. This will allow Patrol Divisions to enter the Zoom waiting room.
- E. Zoom meetings will begin <u>promptly</u> at 0600 hours, 1400 hours, and 2100 hours.

The Watch Commander Line-Up Briefings will tentatively **begin on September 4, 2024, at 0600 hours**. Before the meetings begin, webcams and microphones are currently being installed at each Patrol Division.
