NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

SPECIAL EVENTS DEPARTMENT

PROJECT NAME: Special Event Permit - San Diego Santa Run & Pacific Beach Holiday Parade

COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: Pacific Beach

COUNCIL DISTRICT: 2

LOCATION: Garnet Ave, Cass Street, Felspar St and Hanes Street (see attached maps).

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Special Event Permit for a Santa Run and a holiday parade event that would occur on December 14, 2024, along streets within the Pacific Beach community (see attached maps). The combined events would include the Santa run and parade routes, floats, marching bands, color guards, children's marching groups, animals, stages, a generator, sound amplification, performances, pre-packaged food, canopies, temporary structures, fencing/barriers, portables restrooms, trash/recycling containers, tables, and chairs. Noise associated with the event activities and set-up/dismantling would occur from 5 AM until 4 PM on December 14, 2024. Set-up would occur from 5 AM until 7 AM, the event would occur from 7 AM until 2:30 PM, and dismantling would occur from 2:30 PM until 4 PM.

Road closures associated with the event would be as follows:

Garnet Ave between Mission Blvd & Cass St from 5 AM to 4 PM,
Garnet Ave between Cass St & Ingraham St from 7 AM to 4 PM,
Bayard between Garnet Ave & Hornblend St from 5 AM to 4 PM,
Cass St between Garnet Ave & Turquoise St from 7 AM to 12 PM,
Felspar St between Gresham St. & Ingraham St from 9 AM to 4 PM,
Haines St between Garnet Ave & Felspar St from 9 AM to 4 PM.

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities); Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land); Section 15311 (Accessory Structures).

ENTITY MAKING ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: City of San Diego Mayor-Appointed Designee

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section(s): Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) which allows for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing,

licensing or minor alterations of existing public or private structures or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use; Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land) which allows for minor, temporary use of land that has negligible or no permanent effects on the environment; Section 15311 (Accessory Structures) which allows for construction, or placement of minor structures accessory to existing commercial, industrial, or institutional facilities, including, but not limited to, temporary use items in publicly owned facilities or other facilities designated for public use; and where the exceptions listed in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action; and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.

Applications to appeal CEQA determination to the City Council must be filed with the Office of the Clerk within 10 business days from the date of the posting of this Notice (**December 2, 2024**). Appeals to the City Clerk must be filed via email or in-person as follows:

You must separately mail the appeal fee by check payable to the City Treasurer to: City Clerk/Appeal, MS 2A, 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101. The appeal filing fee must be United States Postal Service (USPS) postmarked) before or on the final date of the appeal.
2. Appeals filed In-Person: The Environmental Determination Appeal Application Form [DS-3031](#) can be obtained at: <https://www.sandiego.gov/sites/default/files/legacy/developmentservices/pdf/industry/forms/ds3031.pdf>. Bring the fully completed appeal application DS-3031 (including grounds for appeal and supporting documentation) to the City Administration Building— Public Information Counter (Open 8:00am to 5:00pm Monday through Friday excluding City approved holidays), 1st Floor Lobby, located at 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101, by 5:00pm on the last day of the appeal period. The completed appeal form shall include the required appeal fee, with a check payable to: City Treasurer.

The appeal application can also be obtained from the City Clerk, 202 'C' Street, 1st Floor Lobby, San Diego, CA 92101. This information will be made available in alternative formats upon request.

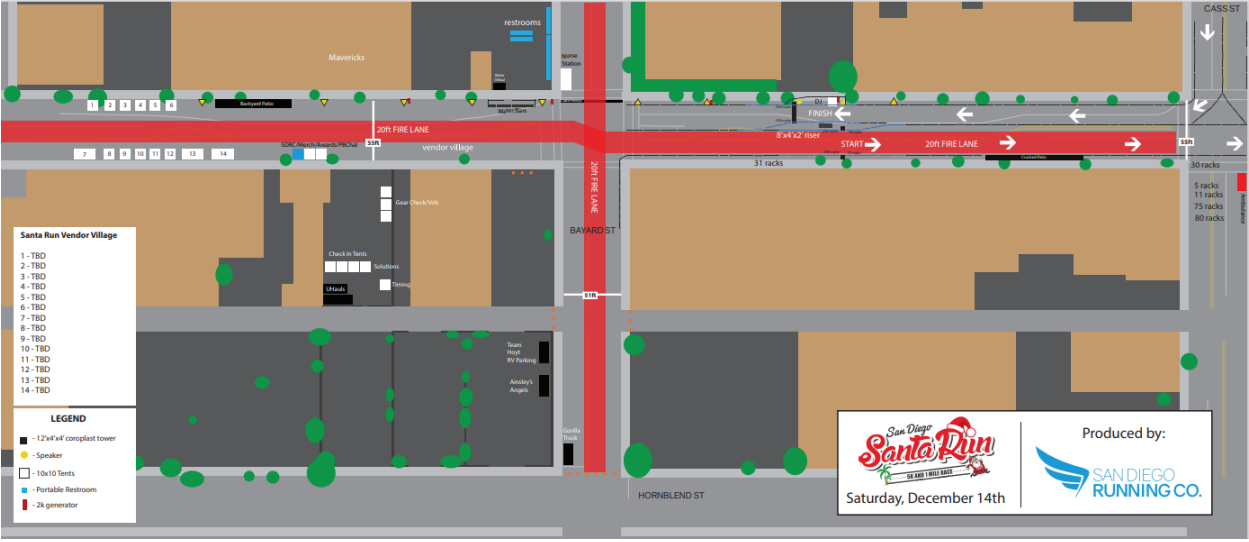

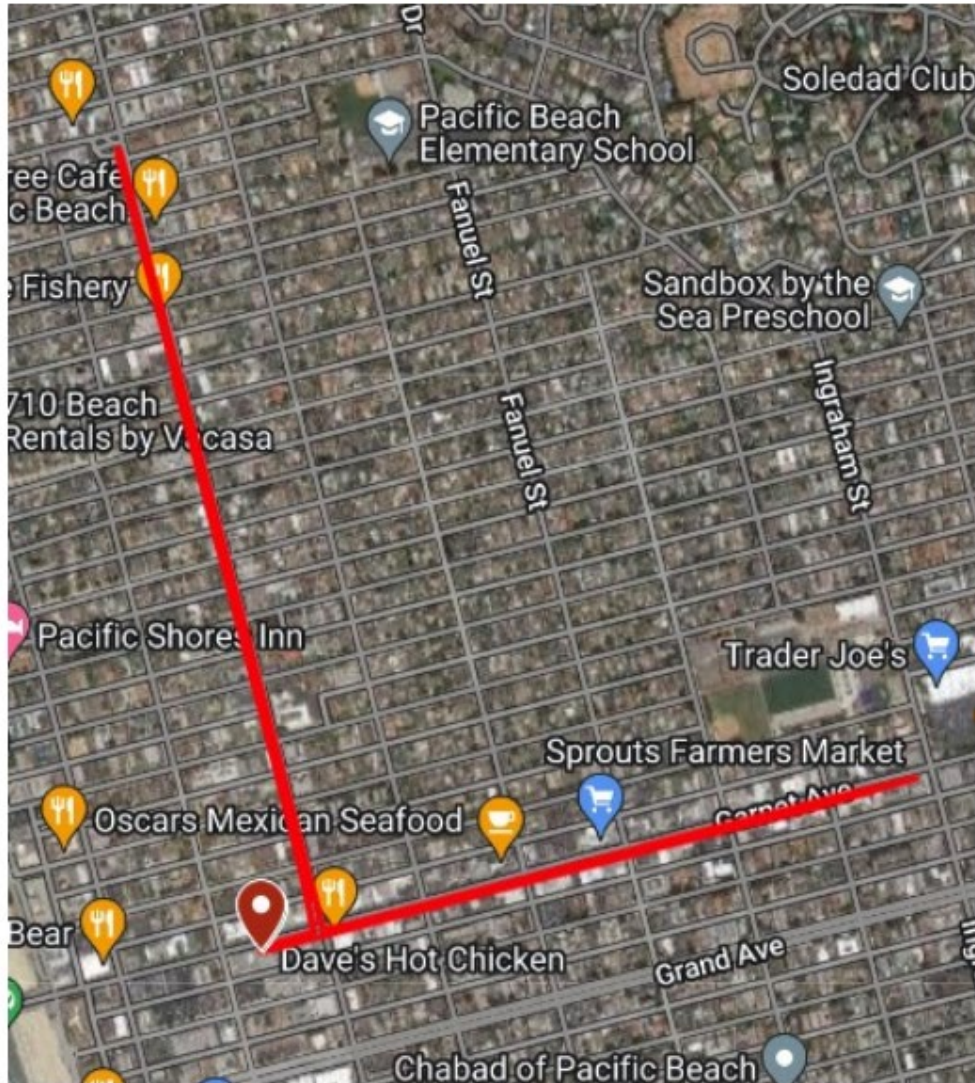

Cass St. between alley south of Garnet Ave & Turquoise St.: **7:00am - 12:00pm**

Course Turn-by-Turn Description

START LINE - 912 Garnet Ave (adjacent to Bank of America) - SOUTH side of Garnet - Runners travel EAST on SOUTH side of the road towards Ingraham St.

U-TURN - Garnet Ave. prior to Ingraham St. - Garnet will be split down the middle - After U-Turn runners will travel WEST on the NORTH side of the road towards Cass St.

RIGHT TURN - Onto Cass St. - Cass fully closed and split down the middle - Runners travel NORTH on EAST side of Cass St. towards Turquoise St.

U-TURN - Cass St. prior to Turquoise St. - After U-Turn runners will travel SOUTH on WEST side of Cass St. towards Garnet Ave.

RIGHT TURN - Onto Garnet Ave. - Runners travel WEST on NORTH side of Garnet Ave. towards Finish Line

FINISH LINE - 912 Garnet Ave. - NORTH side of Garnet runners traveling WEST
