Renovate the recreation center interior, repaint the recreation center exterior with modern colors (not beige), and repaint the Friendship center exterior with modern colors to modernize an outdated facility.</p>	<p>Replace the curb ramp, paths of travel, and playground. Repave the parking lot and modify ADA parking spaces to include paths of travel. Renovate the comfort station to provide ADA access. Install security gates and finish the fencing at the dog park. Renovate and repaint the recreation center with modern colors (not beige) to modernize an outdated facility.</p>	<p>Replace noncompliant curb ramp, playground, and path of travel from parking lot to playground. Repave and restripe parking lot to accommodate more ADA parking spaces and address pavement deterioration. Address erosion control issues by building a retaining wall at the eastern edge of the park.
