SUBJECT: Addition of Conditions to Project No. PRJ-0692722 - FHCSD Clinic

Further staff review has determined that four permit conditions required corrections and one new condition was added.

The revisions to the draft permit (Pages 4-5) are shown below in strikethrough/underline below and attached permit.

ENGINEERING REQUIREMENTS:

- 13. Prior to the issuance of any building permit, the Owner/Permittee shall obtain an Encroachment Maintenance Removal Agreement (EMRA) for curb <u>outlets</u>, landscape and irrigation located within the public right-of-way, satisfactory to the City Engineer.
- 17. Prior to the issuance of any building permit, the Owner/Permittee shall assure by permit and bond the reconstruction of the alley pavement with current City Standard <u>full width</u> concrete alley, adjacent to the site, satisfactory to the City Engineer.
- 24. Development of this project shall comply with all stormwater construction requirements of the State Construction General Permit Order No. 2009-0009DWQ 2022-0057-DWQ. In accordance with Order No. R9-2013-0001 2022-0057-DWQ or subsequent order, a Risk Level Determination shall be calculated for the site and a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) shall be implemented concurrently with the commencement of grading activities.

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- 25. Development of this project shall comply with all permanent stormwater requirements of Municipal Stormwater Permit No. 2013-0001, or subsequent order, and the current version of the City of San Diego's Stormwater Standards Manual.
- 26. Prior to issuance of a grading or a construction permit, a copy of the Notice of Intent (NOI) with a valid Waste Discharge ID number (WDID#) shall be submitted to the City of San Diego as a proof of enrollment under the Construction General Permit. When ownership of the entire site or portions of the site changes prior to filing of the Notice of Termination (NOT), a revised NOI shall be submitted electronically to the State Water Resources Board in accordance with the provisions as set forth in Section II.C of Order No. 2009-0009-DWQ 2022-0057-DWQ and a copy shall be submitted to the City.
