Coleen Clementson gave brief update on the Strategic Framework and Housing discussions that are ongoing. The Affordable Housing Task Force should have a report available by the end of the month with all the information that they have complied with respect to affordable housing. Within the next few days, the Pilot Villages short list projects will be announced to the public. APA award winners were announced.
