MOTION BY GARCIA TO CONTINUE TO SEPTEMBER 11, 2003 FOR STAFF AND THE APPLICANT TO COME BACK WITH THE FOLLOWING: TO LOOK AT THE ISSUE OF ENCROACHMENT INTO THE NATURAL SLOPES AND THE LIMITATION OF THE FILL THAT IS MOVING INTO THE PREVIOUSLY NON-DISTURBED PORTIONS OF THE SITE; WHAT THE DEED RESTRICTION INCLUDES; AND CLARIFICATION OF THE VIEW FINDINGS. Second by Chase. Passed by a 5-0 vote with Vice-Chairperson Schultz not present and Commissioner Steele recusing.
