On motion of KARL ZOBELL, seconded by RALPH PESQUEIRA, the Commission voted 5-0 (BERNET not present) to continue this item to December 3, 1992, at 9:00 a.m. in order for the applicant, opposition and staff to meet to discuss the issues of the Arroyo Sorrento Road with and alignment, and the traffic generation rates assigned to the project.
