RANCHO PENASQUITOS COMMUNITY PLAN UPDATE. CERTIFY ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT NO. 89-1222; ADOPT FINDINGS AND A STATE OF OVERRIDING CONSIDERATIONS; CONSIDER ADOPTION OF THE RANCHO PENASQUITOS COMMUNITY PLAN UPDATE AS PRESENTED IN THE NOVEMBER 1992 DRAFT, AND CONTINUE THE PLANNING COMMISSION HEARING TO JANUARY 28, 1993.

CHARLES STUDEN presented Planning Department Report No. P-92-264.

KEVIN McNAMARA, Chairman of the Rancho Penasquitos Planning Board. He addressed concerns to the Anaheim Hills and Montana Mirador; CPIOZ, intersection of Carmel Mountain Road and I-15.

SCOTT ELAM, representing I-15 Diamond Gateway Chamber of Commerce, we represent Rancho Penasquitos Carmel Mountain Ranch and Sabre Springs; family owns Elam Hallmark. He spoke in opposition to the proposed discretionary use permits, this update plan is unnecessary.

C. LAURA THORNTON, community planning liaison with NAS Miramar. She addressed the issue of noise from Miramar and developments in the western Mira Mesa and Rancho Penasquitos.

FRED KUHN, manager of La Quinta Motor Inns. He had concerns about the proposed zones on commercial property owner rights; discretionary use permit, and overlay zone.

Public testimony was closed.

COMMISSION ACTION

On motion of VERNA QUINN, seconded by RALPH PESQUEIRA, the Commission voted 6-0 (BENN not present) recommend to staff that they discuss and review the Planning Committee recommendations and bring that back, January 28, 1993; that slides and topographical maps of the area be provided.

On motion of RALPH PESQUEIRA, seconded by as amended by SCOTT BERNET, the Commission voted 4-2 (QUINN and ZOBELL voting in the negative with BENN not present) to the Planning Department as amended to strengthen the language in the commercial section, specifically addressing a policy that deals with communities and the redevelopment commercial properties communicate.

COMMISSION ACTION

On motion of RALPH PESQUEIRA, seconded by KARL ZOBELL, the Commission voted 5-1 (QUINN voting in the negative with BENN not present) recommend against CPIOZ, but the addition of language discussed, to the Planning Department.

On motion RALPH PESQUEIRA, seconded by VERNA QUINN, the Commission voted 6-0 (BENN not present) to continued to January 28, 1993, at 9:00 a.m.
