Workshop #1 Community Feedback - Jan 9th, 2024

Meeting Notes/Comments:

- 40-50 community members in attendance, majority were there in support of pickleball & padel facilities
- Community members noted the following:
 - Facility should be publicly accessible and not a private facility
 - Facility should allow for inclusiveness of all levels of play & be suitable space for children
 - All courts should be lighted to allow for evening play
 - Court booking costs need to be reasonable
 - Some green space should be maintained in that section of the park
 - While indoor pickleball options are available, there are no outdoor pickleball or padel facilities in the Carmel Valley area (the sport is intended to be played on a hard court)
 - Court orientation needs to be kept in mind
 - Public restroom facilities should be easily accessible
 - Refreshment options would be a huge plus given existing facilities in San Diego typically have limited to no offerings
 - This area in the park is utilized currently by sports groups and for occasional community events (movie nights, birthday parties etc.)

Note: There were many specific design discussions related to example renderings that were shown that occurred during this workshop that were outside the scope of the meetings intended purpose




Carmel Valley Recreation Council

On June 11th, 2024, the Carmel Valley Recreation Council approved an action item in a 6-3 vote recommending that a letter be sent to the Park and Recreation Department Director asking that

the GDP for Carmel Valley Community Park be amended to include a hard-court area in the north-western section of the park, that was previously intended for multi-sport arenas.

From the park's initial development, the Carmel Valley Recreation Council and the Carmel Valley Community at large have had an ongoing interest in the installation of multi -sport arenas within the park. The multi sport arenas were not included in the park's final design entirely due to a shortage of funding. From those early days it has remained a goal of the Recreation Council to one day complete a sport arenas project.


In our meeting Tuesday night August 6th the Carmel Valley Recreation council unanimously approved the recommendation for a letter to be written to the Park and Recreation department asking to amend the General Development Plan for the Carmel Valley Community Park to include and allow for the development of indoor arenas on the small multi-use field on the west side of the parking area.

The meeting was well attended by most of the at large members, most of the sports groups and 3 members of the public looking to be addedwhile the discussion was short the sentiment was very favorable because it would turn an area of little use now to one that could be utilized by a much larger user base.


