A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ESTABLISHING COUNCIL POLICY NO. 700-48 PERTAINING TO PROCEDURES FOR DISTRIBUTION AND USE OF OPPORTUNITY FUND FEES.

WHEREAS, in response to the 2021 Parks Master Plan and the 2021 Audit of Equity in Recreation Programming, the Parks and Recreation Department developed a new user fee, the Opportunity Fund Fee, as part of the 2022 Department Fee Schedule update; and

WHEREAS, Opportunity Fund Fees will be assessed to permitted user groups per the Parks and Recreation Department Fee Schedule. The Mayor, or designee, will allocate and disburse funds to be spent in accordance with this policy for Parks and Recreation Department programs, equipment, supplies, projects, or other purposes beneficial to the Parks and Recreation Department; and

WHEREAS, a special fund, the Opportunity Fund, was established to collect the Opportunity Fund Fees, as outlined in Resolution R-313898; and

WHEREAS, the policy provides guidelines for distribution of the Opportunity Fund Fees which will include an Objective Scoring System to identify which recreation center funds are eligible for consideration. Each fiscal year distribution of Opportunity Fund Fees is determined according to the Objective Scoring System, or at the discretion of the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department. Fees will be distributed into that year's approved Recreation Center Funds during the first quarter of the subsequent fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that Council Policy 700-48 pertaining to procedures for distribution and use of Opportunity Fund Fees is established as set forth in the Council Policy filed in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-

314733
