Man Arrested for Burglaries in 4S Ranch, University City

San Diego – A man was arrested this morning for two burglaries in the University City and 4S Ranch areas and a felony warrant. He was taken into custody near California State Road 56 and Camino Del Sur exit. During the arrest, officers located a sledgehammer and clothing that was worn for both incidents.

San Diego Police Officers responded to two separate burglaries located at 16480 Paseo Del Sur at around 3:30 a.m. During the preliminary investigation, officers gathered information concerning the suspect description. They also received a confirmation from SDPD's Automated License Plate Recognition (ALPR) system for a vehicle that was in the area at the same time the incident occurred. The officers proactively shared the information citywide.

Meanwhile, officers responded to a third burglary at 3851 Governor Drive at around 4:30 a.m. The suspect was not at the location. While investigating, officers received another ALPR notification nearby of the same vehicle that was involved in the burglaries at 16480 Paseo Del Sur.

Officers later located the vehicle traveling eastbound on California State Road 56 from the Interstate 5 freeway. Officers were not actively pursuing the vehicle. The suspect exited the freeway at the Camino Del Sur off-ramp and spun out into a nearby ice plant. Officers successfully took the suspect into custody without incident. During the arrest, officers found a sledgehammer along with additional evidence.

The suspect has been identified as 33-year-old Robert Abduljabar Coleman. SDPD is currently investigating the incidents and has not determined whether Coleman is the suspect for similar burglaries.
